The Quakers lived in Newberry, South Carolina, during the Revolutionary War era and into the early decades of 1800s when they began moving to the newly opened western territories and to the northwest. The Historic Bush River Cemetery was part of their Meeting House property and was the final resting place of hundreds of their members.

This completely indexed history of the Cemetery and many of its families includes photographs of all of the existing monuments and a map of tombstone locations. **All book sale proceeds will go to the Quaker Cemetery Clean Up Fund for the monthly maintenance of the Bush River Cemetery. Because of this fundraising effort, the Cemetery is now accessible every day of the year.**

Marker is before you reach the bridge over Bush River or the Quaker Road. (GPS, aprx 34.2280, -81.6390)

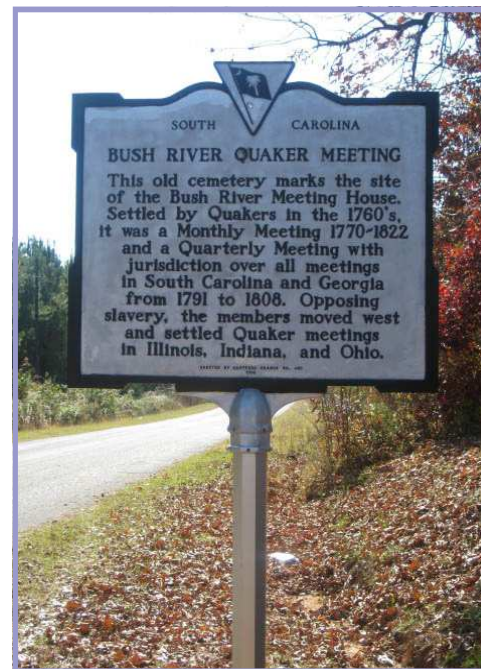

On January 21, 2002, a group of 50 descendants and friends of the Quakers in Newberry gathered at the Historic Bush River Quaker Cemetery to begin a long-term project of maintenance and protection. We called the project "Preserving Our Heritage." Some traveled from as far away as Texas; some lived just up the road. But we were all there on a rainy winter day to clean the Cemetery and to make plans for its future.

Since then we have continued our efforts. We can't always be there ourselves to clean the Cemetery, but we are committed to making sure that it is always properly maintained. We want visitors to have access to the gravesites at all times of the year.

We have recently completed and published a complete survey and map of the graves and inscriptions to be given to local and national libraries. (See below for sales details.) **We have pledged all sales proceeds to the preservation and protection of the Cemetery.** The North Carolina Yearly Meeting of the Society of Friends still owns the property and has been a great support in our efforts.



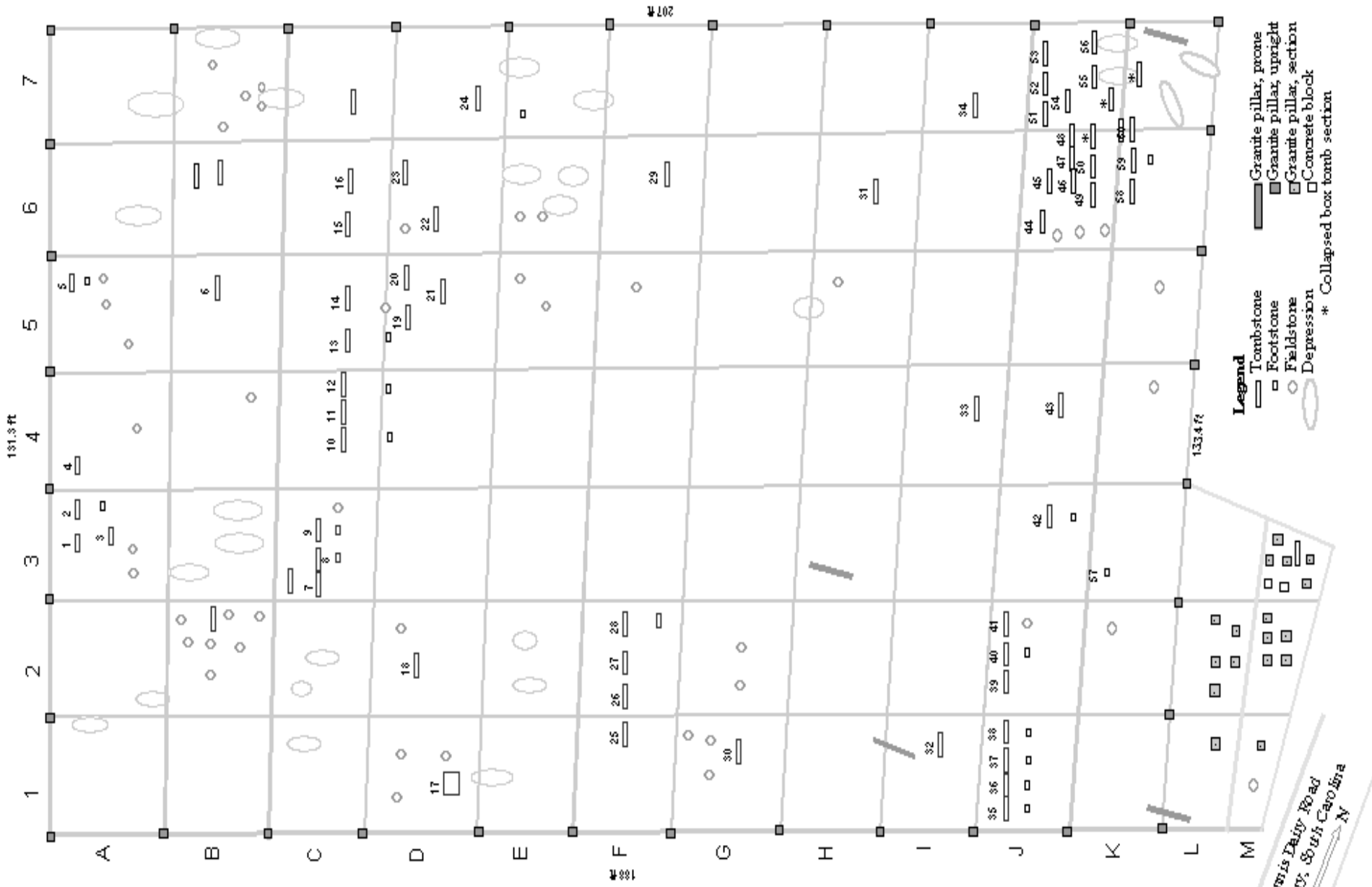
